Effective May 1, 2009, Nestle Confections will again guarantee their products to the retail stores. This program will be in effect for the duration of the 2009 calendar year to be re-evaluated prior to 2010.

Only products that are past the freshness date or are restockable/resalable at the wholesale level will receive 100% credit. Open boxes containing products still within the freshness date range have been defined by Nestle as "Illegitimate Returns" and will not receive credit.
